



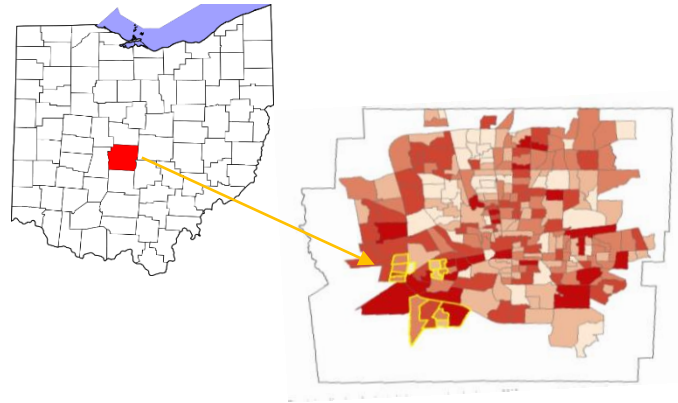
Franklin County Public Health's Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Initiative

Targets Three Communities:

Grove City - Prairie Township - Franklin Township

Focuses on Two Initiatives:

- Preventing Youth Initiation
- Preventing Exposure to Secondhand Smoke



Youth Prevention:

- Initiate and foster the development of a STAND group in the South-Western City School District.
- Increase awareness and knowledge of decision makers in the focus areas about the availability and access to tobacco products in their respective communities.
- Increase the number of schools in the South-Western City School District that have adopted comprehensive tobacco-free policies.

Smoke and Tobacco-Free Policies:

- Increase community awareness of the impact of smoke and tobacco-free policies on the social norms of the community.
- Increase the number of outdoor spaces in the focus communities that are covered by tobacco-free policies.
- Increase the number of public and private multi—unit housing complexes in the focus communities that have adopted smoke-free policies.
- Increase community awareness of Ohio's Smoke Free Workplace Law in the focus communities through increased signage and appropriate reporting.
