The CMH has three programs to help children with special health care needs: Diagnostic Program, Treatment Program, and Service Coordination Program.

Duties Include:

- Referrals to appropriate doctors, other services and support
- Home visitations
- Parent education
- Pediatric assessments
- Provide vaccinations to the public and other related duties as assigned.

Requirements:

Must be a Registered Nurse with the State of Ohio and current CPR certification. Bachelor's Degree from an accredited College of Nursing preferred; at least 1 year experience with pediatrics or public health preferred. Case management experience preferred. Must possess a valid driver's license, and be insurable through FCPH's provider. Some evening and weekend hours required.

Salary: \$23.29/hourly starting. This is a non-exempt position.
